We want to take responsibility for the individual unaccompanied children and refugee youth, and help them find safety, discover their worth, and build a future perspective.

Job summary:

The purpose of the Integration Program Officer in the Horizon Center is to develop the curricula for the Integration Training Program, as well as to facilitate the classes while supporting the students throughout the process. Along with the main purpose, the Integration Program Officer will be working with the Integration Program Team Leader and team to support the overall development and execution of the program.

Duties and Key Responsibilities:

Curricula Development & Class Facilitation:

- To be responsible for the development and design of curricula for the Integration Training Program; including learning activities, assignments, and assessments.
- To facilitate classes & workshops according to curricula content.
- To motivate and engage youth to participate in the Horizon program

- To be responsible for all tasks relating to student registration, participation, and graduation processes occur. This includes the monitoring, recording, and reporting of class/workshop activities.
- To conduct regular evaluations and revisions of educational materials to ensure high standards of suitability and effectiveness.

Program Development:

- To support the Integration Program Team Leader in developing and implementing project activities to meet project deliverables, based on timeline and scope.
- To work closely with the Integration Program team for the development of the program's road map with new goals for new phases, which are aligned with the vision and mission of the organization.
- To organize and conduct focus group discussions and surveys to ensure the relevancy of the program.
- To research initiatives in relation to refugee integration and propose Faros' involvement in selected projects that are aligned with the program goals.

Other General Tasks:

- To support the drafting of concept documents for the further advancement and promotion of the Integration Program, upon request.
- To provide administrative support, when needed.

Education / Experience needed:

- Bachelor's Degree in Teaching and related experience.
- Experience teaching refugee youth, especially those with little formal education will be an asset.
- Experience implementing programs for refugees.
- Experience working in multicultural teams is preferable.
